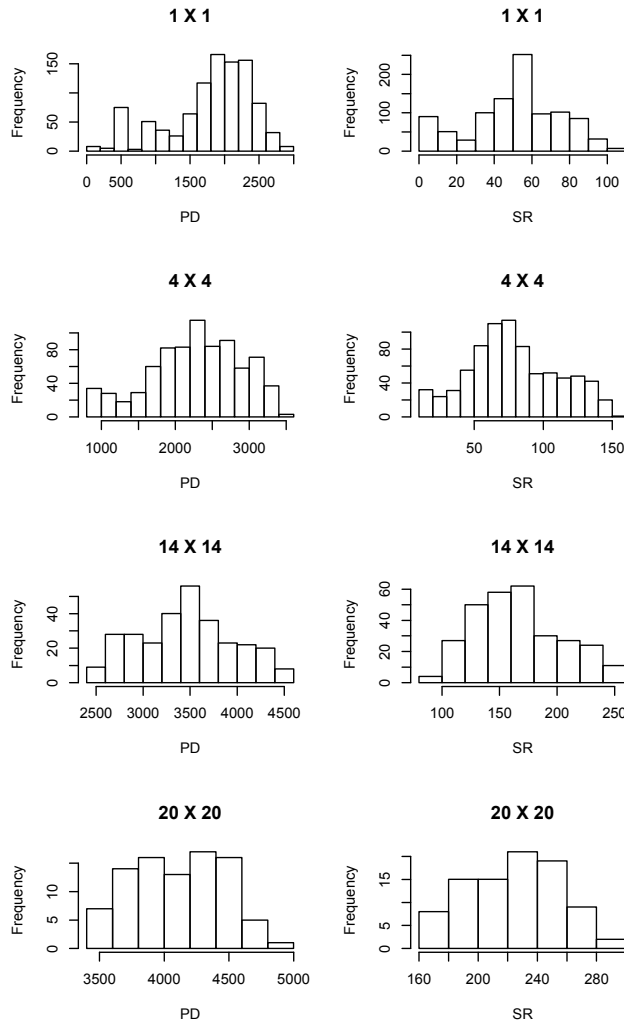

## **Appendix A. Distribution of species richness and phylogenetic diversity values.**

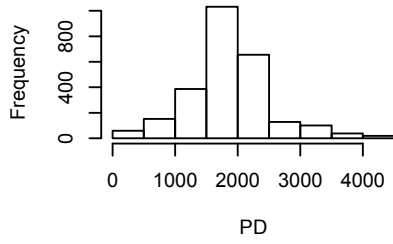
