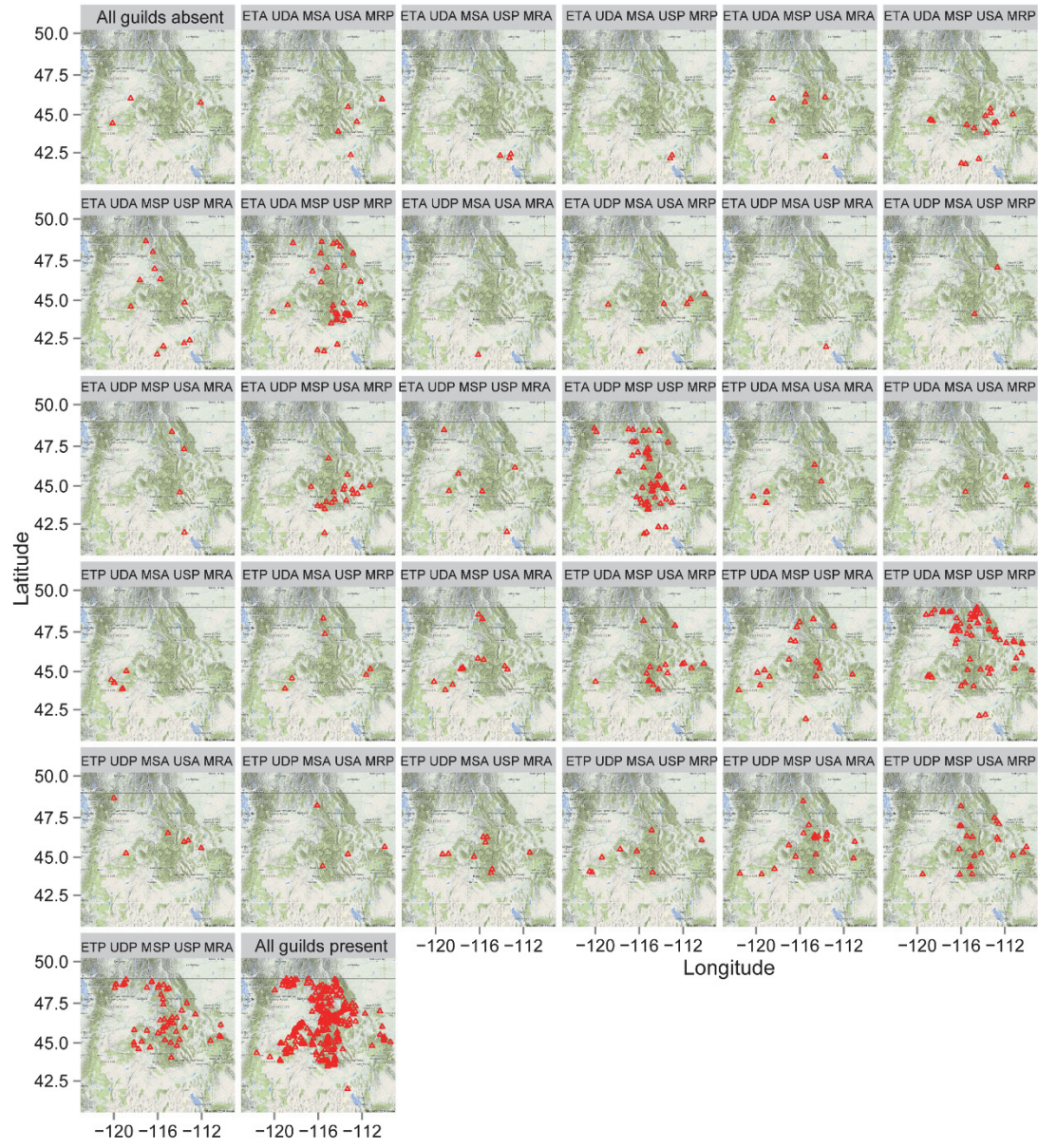

Fig. E1. Map of combinations of guild assemblages across the Columbia and Missouri River basins showed that a majority of reaches contained all possible guilds. Only a few reaches were absent of all woody guilds. Map labels consist of guild initials and “P” for guild presence and “A” for guild absence. For example, UDP corresponds to *upland disturbance present* while ETA corresponds to *evergreen tree absent*, etc.
